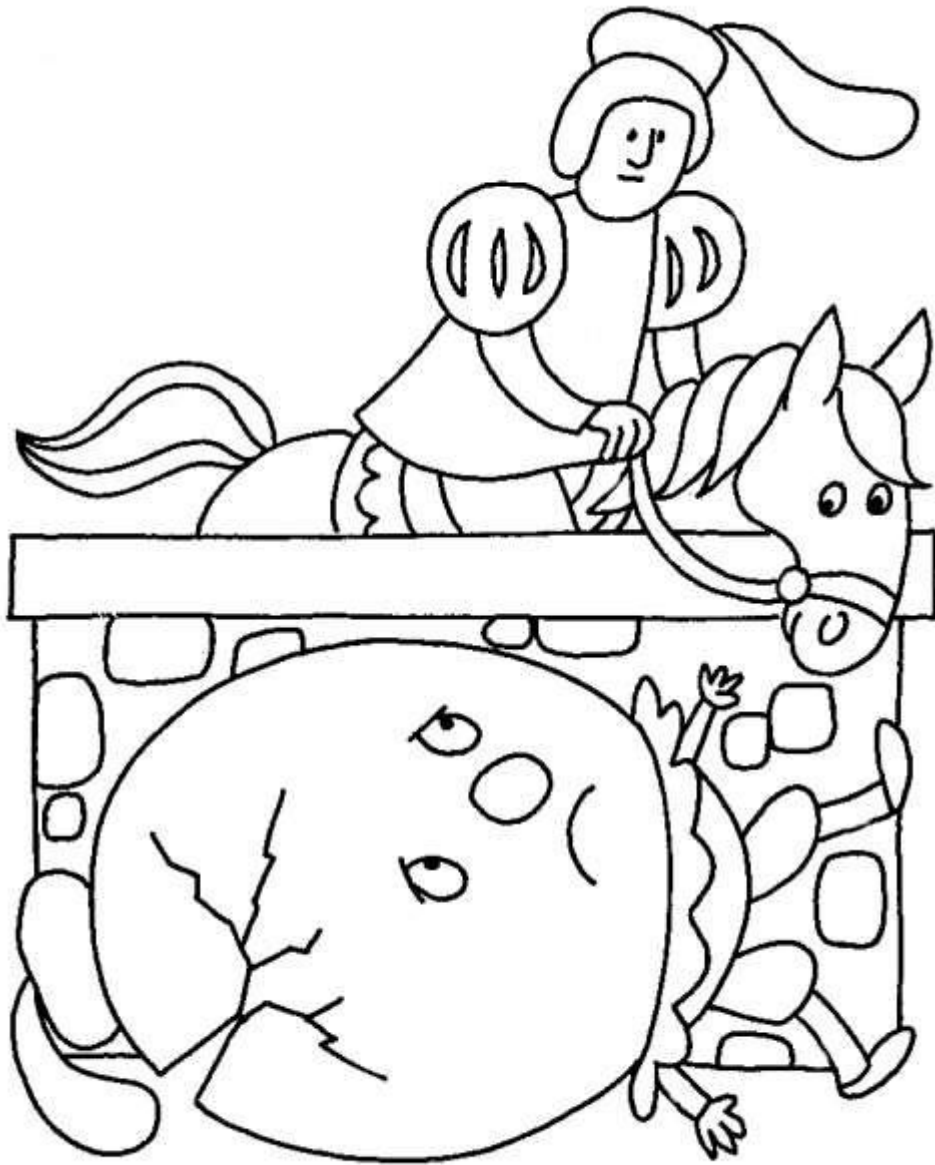

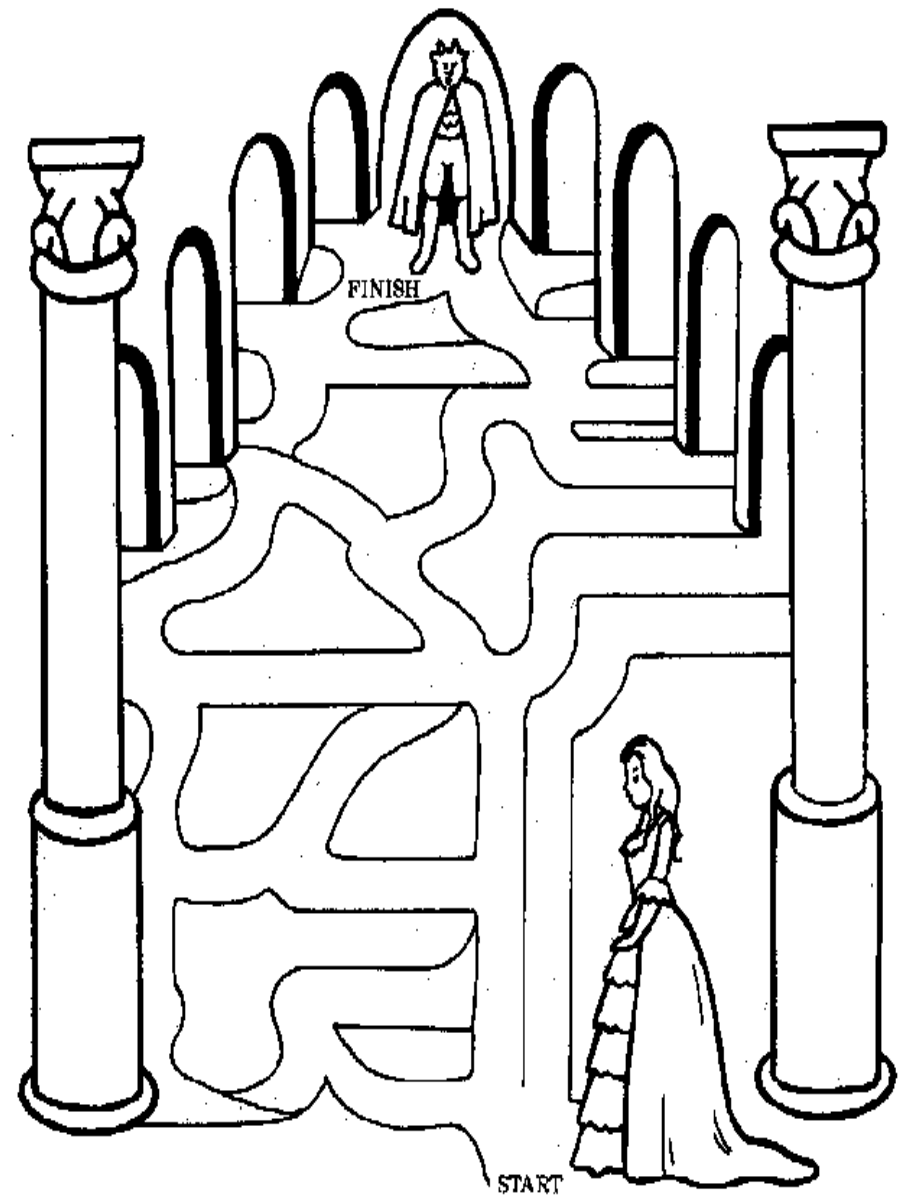

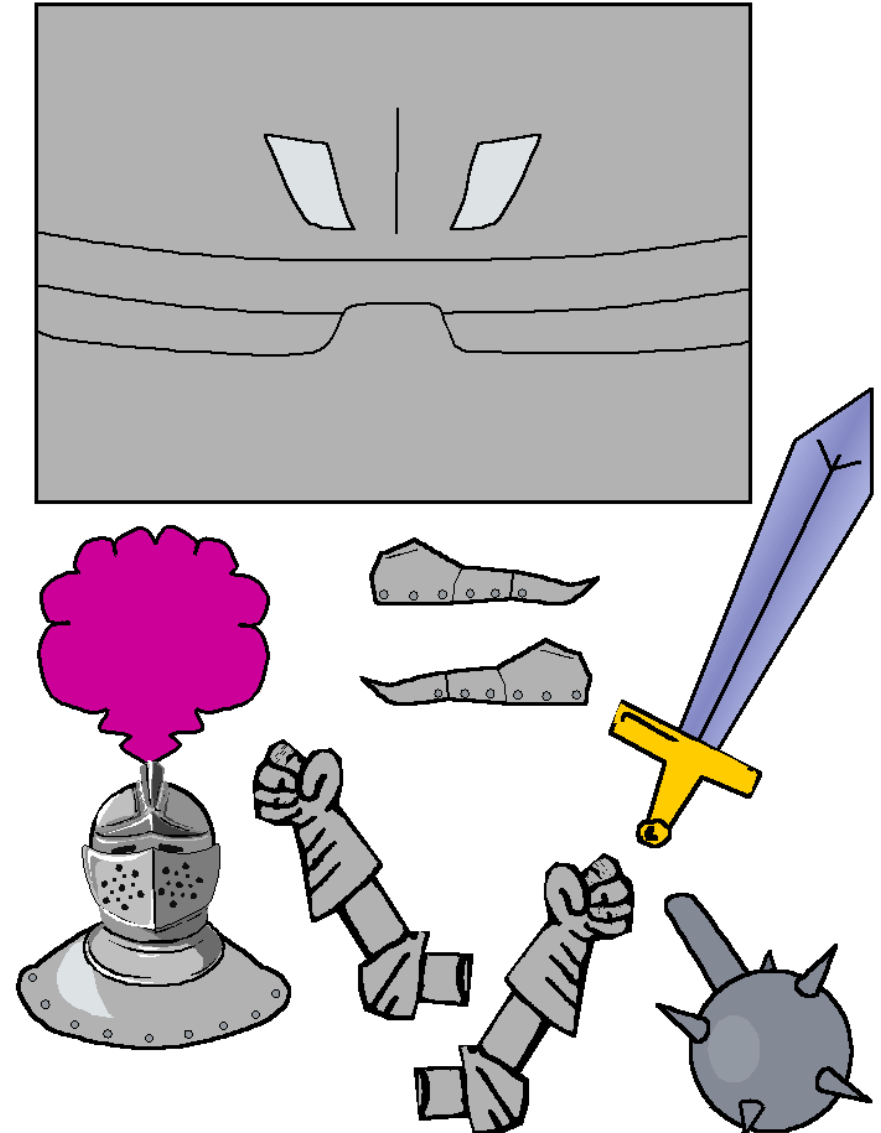
A note from the director...

More panto fun...

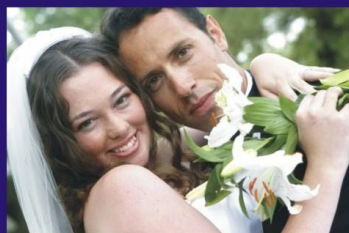
Make the one of the King's Men, roll the large piece into a tube and glue the other pieces on in the right place.
