A big 'thank you,' goes to Kevin and the stage crew for setting and decorating the room, and to those who have prepared the food. The show would not be possible without any of them!



Remember – the show starts as soon as you enter; you are a character and everyone in the room is a suspect! The clues are all there and I wish you the best of luck!


We hope to welcome you back for our next production 'Sleeping Beauty,' in January.


