## Those Were The Days

From Music Hall to Rock n Roll

Come and join us for an evening of nostalgia - initially taking you back to 1900, the Edwardians and the heyday of the Music Hall, with songs such as "My Old Man". We then take you musically through the 10s and 20s (and the First World War) with songs and sketches including "Good Bye Dolly", "Me and My Shadow", "Side by Side" and others as we conclude Act I in the 1930s.

We recommence Act II during World War II in the 30s and 40s with some sketches and songs including "A Nightingale Sang in Berkeley Square", "Bye Bye Blackbird" and "Over the Rainbow". We then move into the 50s and 60s and the age of musicals and Rock n Roll - "Sit Down You're Rocking the Boat", "Singing in the Rain and more - concluding with a Rock n Roll medley.





Spanning 60 years of music, poems and sketches this should be an evening not to be missed. The period has covered some major historic events and saw massive

changes in social norms, technology and commerce - as well as big advances in entertainment - and a population growth from 1.6bn to 3.6bn.

Musically this has included Jazz, Swing, Delta Blues, Bebop, Rock n Roll, Big Bands, Crooners, Doo-Wop, Motown, Reggae, Soul and Pop.
