

After Shakespeare, Alan Ayckbourn is the most performed writer in the English-speaking theatre. In 'Confusions', an early work from 1976, we can see why he has, over the years, captivated his huge audiences. His work is funny but poignant, farcical but truthful and, above all, he creates characters who we like because of, not despite of, their faults. We know all the characters in these five short plays; they are in our families, our communities, our workplaces and, you may find with one or more of the characters, in you. We do not laugh at them but rather in recognition of the frailties we all share and the inevitability of failure in human relationships. Even so the human spirit is alive in all of them and they will all survive and keep trying. We have set the play very firmly in the mid-1970's which is reflected in the décor, costumes and music.

As always the group has worked very hard to put this production together. The cast have risen to the challenge of mastering Ayckbourn's dialogue which is characterised by the pauses, repetitions and false starts of human speech. All of them are playing at least two roles across the five plays which is also hugely demanding. I could have not have asked for more from such a talented group of actors.

The technical challenge of staging the five plays is huge; to ensure a smooth transition between the five very different settings [living-room, hotel bar, restaurant, canvas marquee, town park] I am hugely indebted, as ever, to Charlotte, Kevin, Andy and Ian for working so hard on the set and handling the other technical elements of the production so effectively.

I am confident you will enjoy the production.
